- **Applying the resources necessary** to achieve our energy efficiency and conservation targets. Base is committed to implementing operational reforms that lead to improved returns on energy consumed.
- **Developing and implementing a strategic plan** to guide our efforts and ensure efficiency and conservation objectives are met in the longer term.
