

## KENYA RED CROSS SOCIETY HUMANITARIAN AWARDS

The annual humanitarian awards celebrate ‘exemplary support and great contribution with devotion to the Society’s humanitarian course’.

The awards recognise outstanding contribution in a number of categories – those of individual members, volunteers, groups, institutions, corporates and other organisations that have made special contributions and offered exemplary service in alleviating human suffering in Kenya.

At the awards ceremony held on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016, Base Titanium was recognised in the corporate category for its contributions towards:

1. The Nyalani irrigation scheme in Kwale County, in partnership with the Red Cross and other donors, by funding, training and supporting farmers in creating sustainable livelihood enhancement programmes and developing opportunities and markets to integrate them into the broader economy.
2. Supporting emergency responses led by the Red Cross in relation to flooding events in Vumbu and Vanga.
3. Developing emergency preparedness plans with the Red Cross and local communities create awareness and running live training exercises.
4. Promoting First Aid training as an important life skill amongst Kwale youth.
